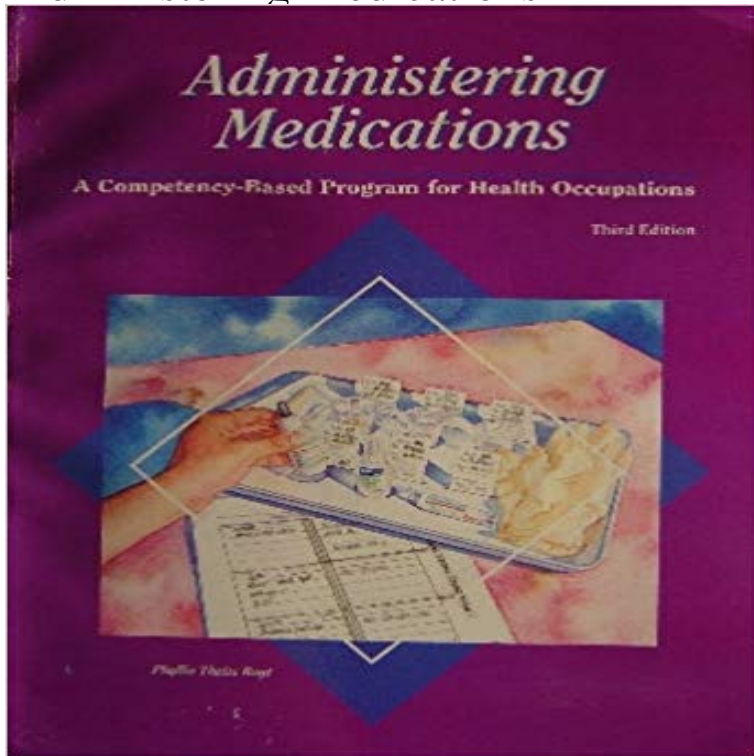


# Administering Medications
