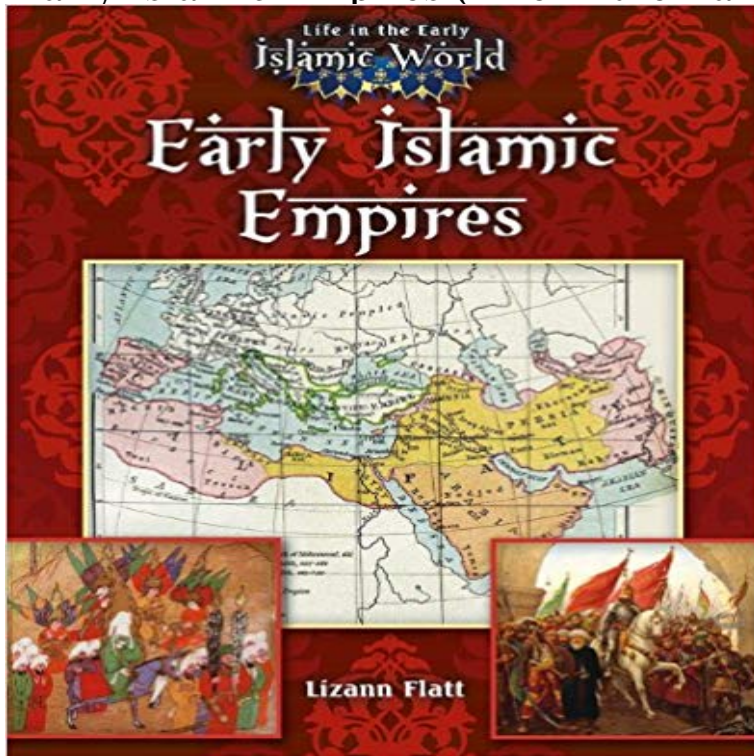


Early Islamic Empires (Life in the Early Islamic World)
