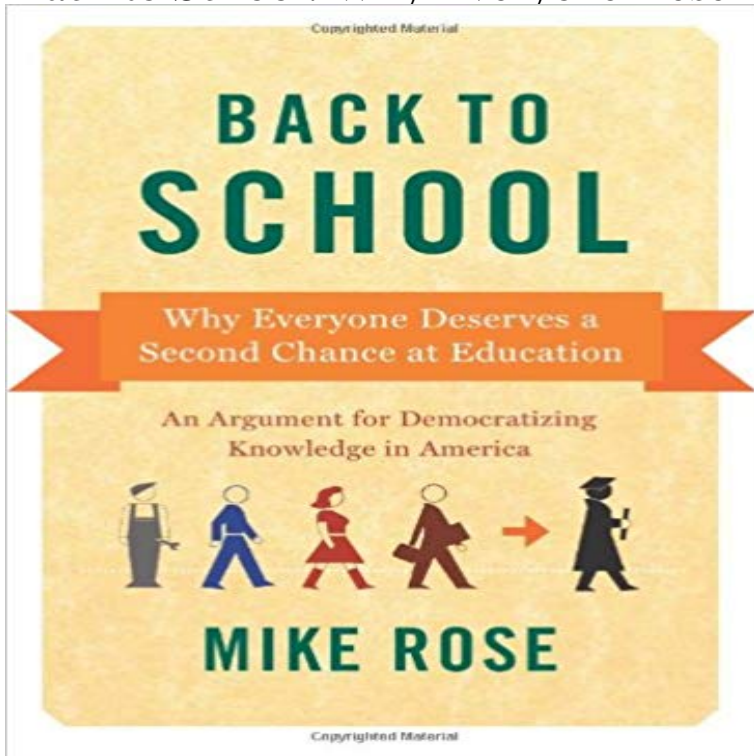


Back to School: Why Everyone Deserves A Second Chance at Education
