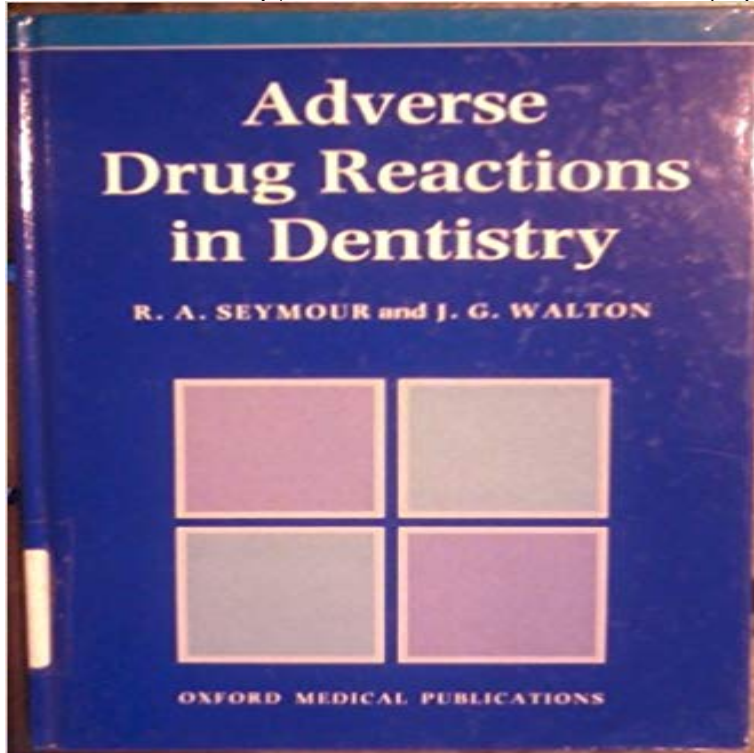


## Adverse Drug Reactions in Dentistry (Oxford Medical Publications)
