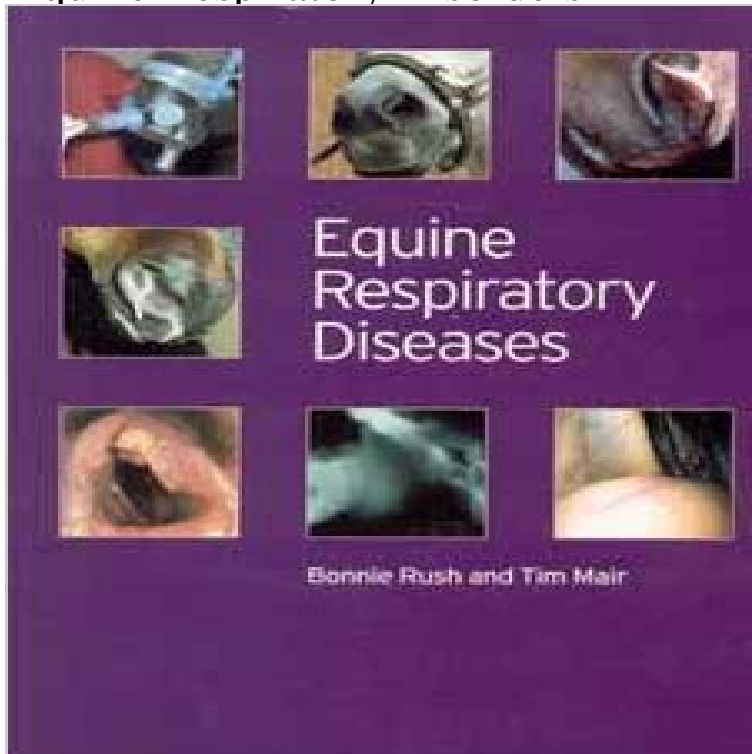


Equine Respiratory Disorders
