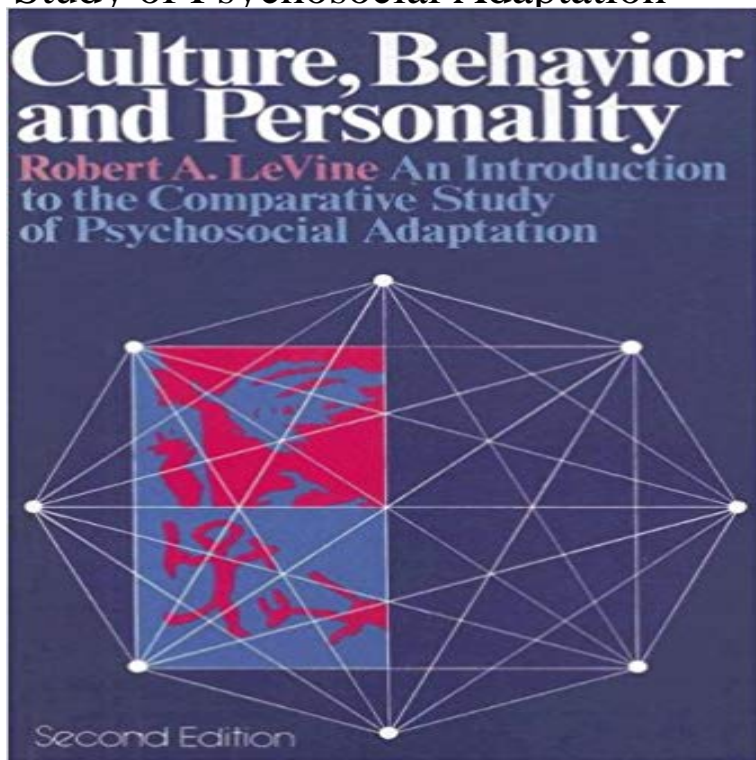


# Culture, Behavior, and Personality: An Introduction to the Comparative Study of Psychosocial Adaptation
