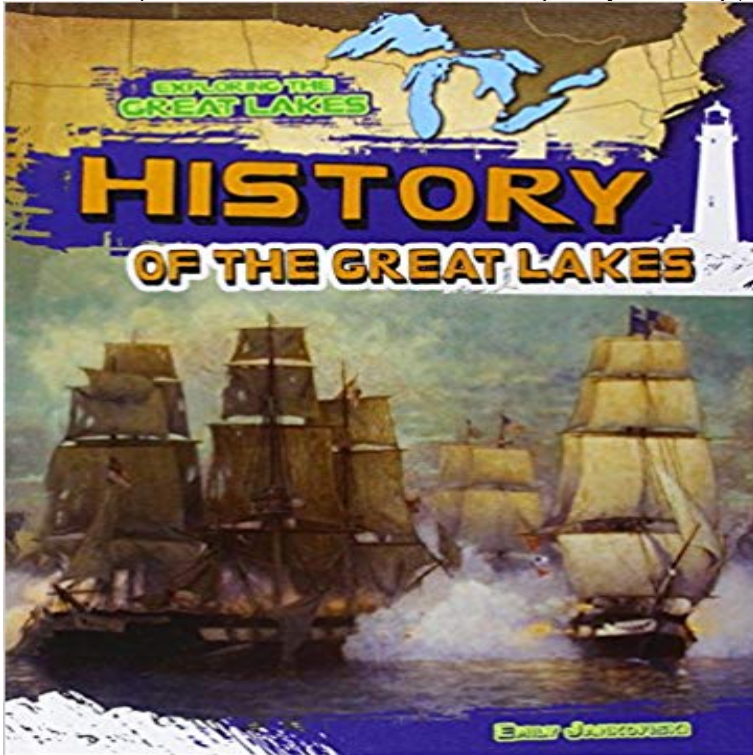


History of the Great Lakes (Exploring the Great Lakes)
