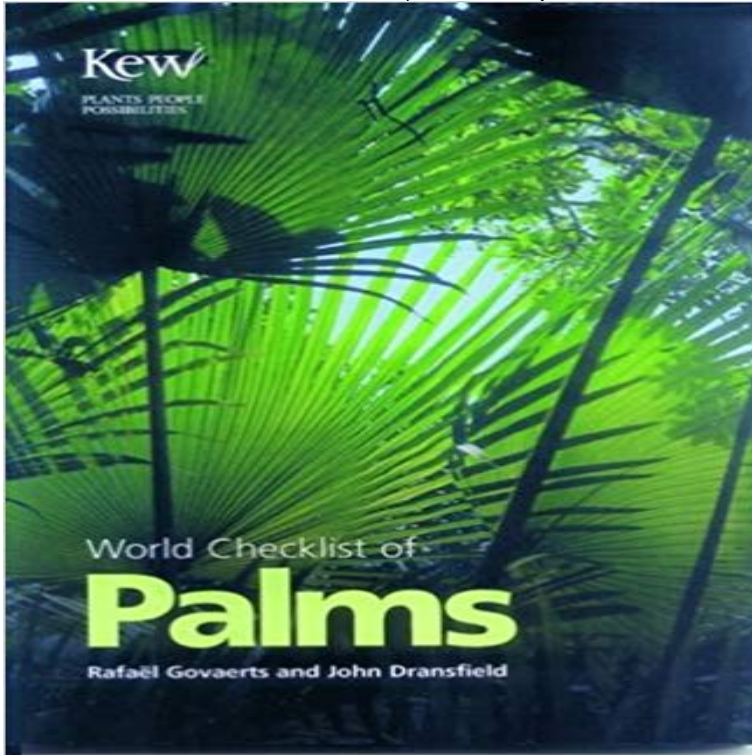


Kew Bulletin: No. 4, 2004 (World Checklist)
