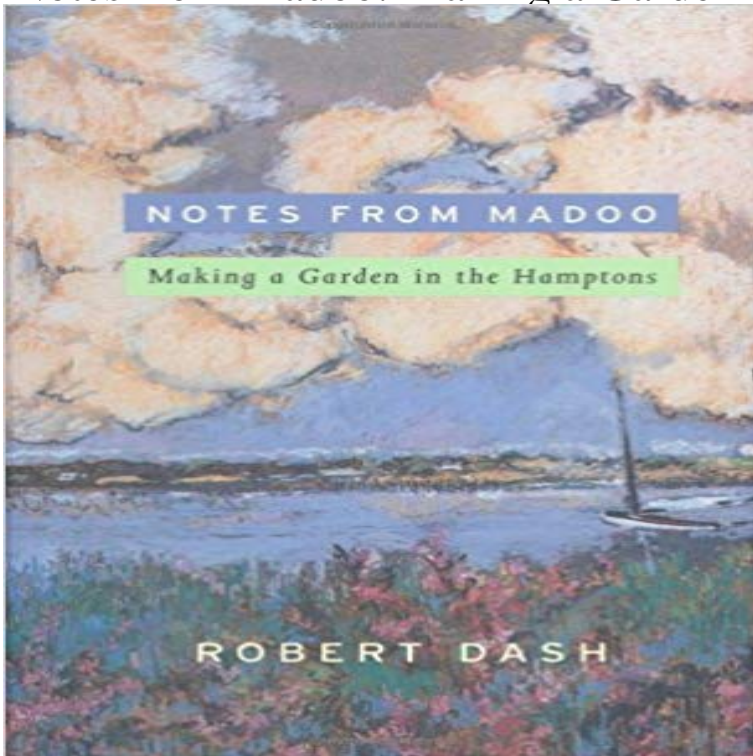


## Notes from Madoo: Making a Garden in the Hamptons



Madoo is an artists unusual and beautiful garden at the far end of Long Island. Now the author/artist/gardener describes his making of Madoo in a book that is as charming and entertaining as it is enlightening. Dashes artists sense --or senses -- of the movement of air and the effects of light and color suffuse all his writings, and show us new ways to look at our own gardens. As with Henry Mitchells books, one learns more from reading these essays than from a dozen how-to books. And whether we like to make gardens or simply to look at them, Dash has given us a book to keep by the bedside, where we can read and reread our favorite pieces (Fairies? Manuring? The Name of the Rose? The Garden Tour? Too many to list!) over and over again.
