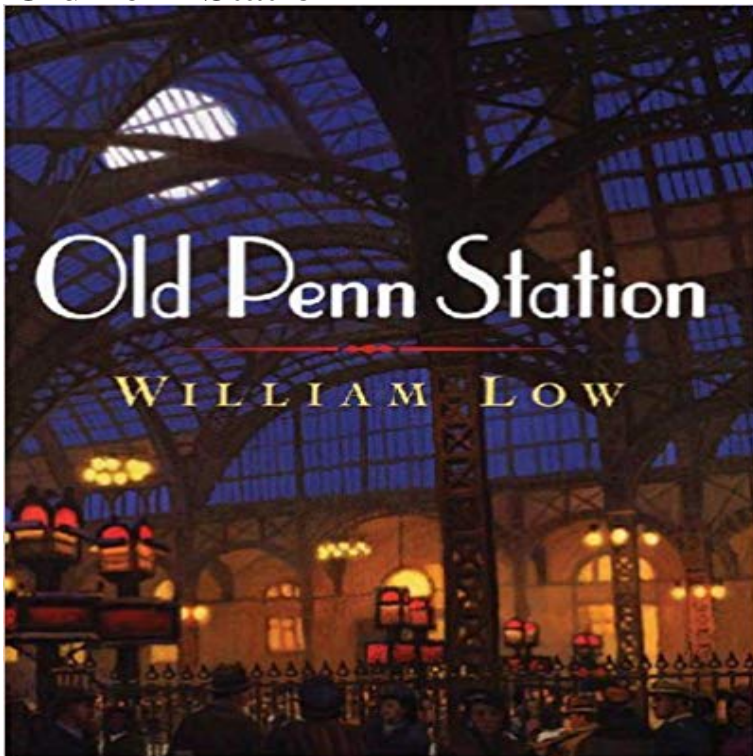


Old Penn Station
