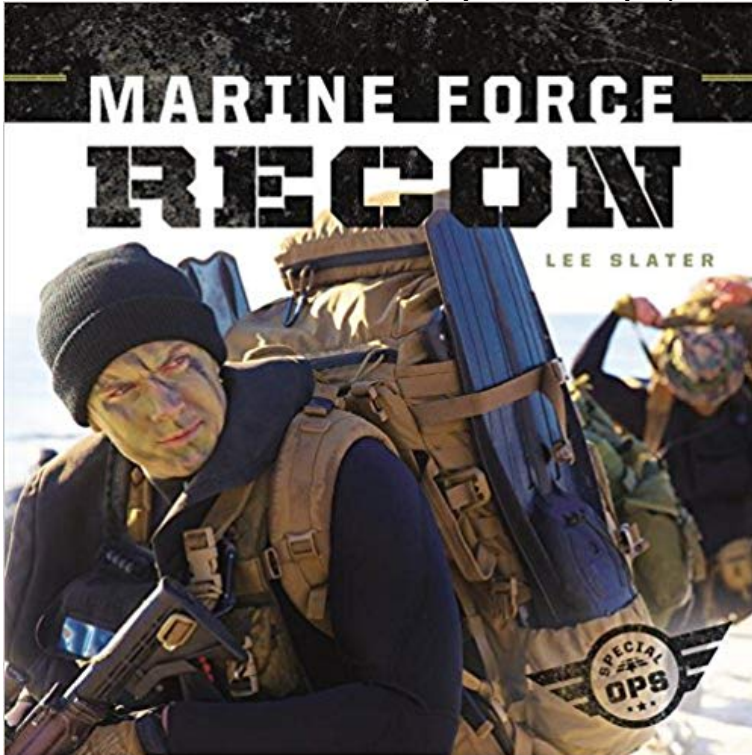


## Marine Force Recon (Special Ops)
