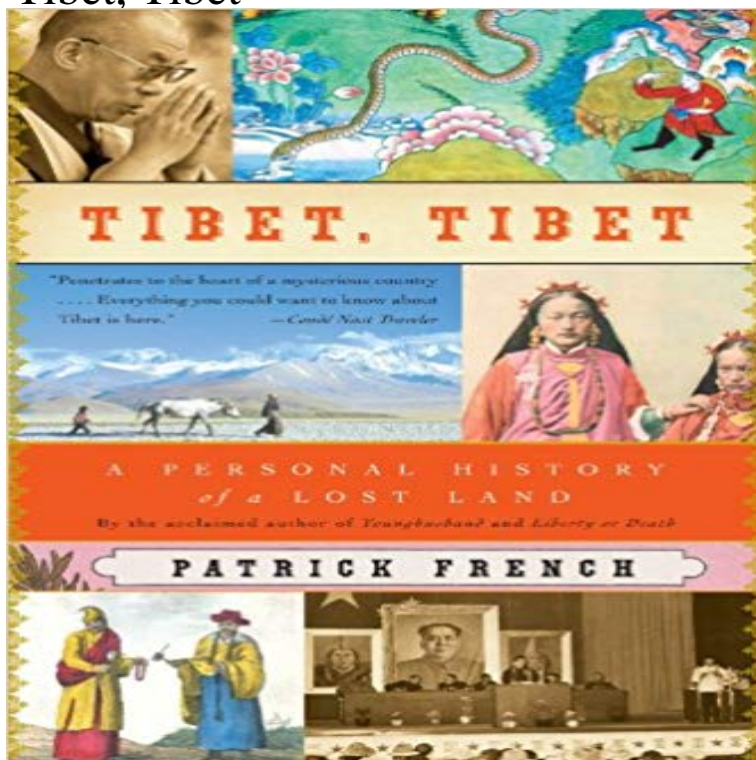


## Tibet, Tibet
