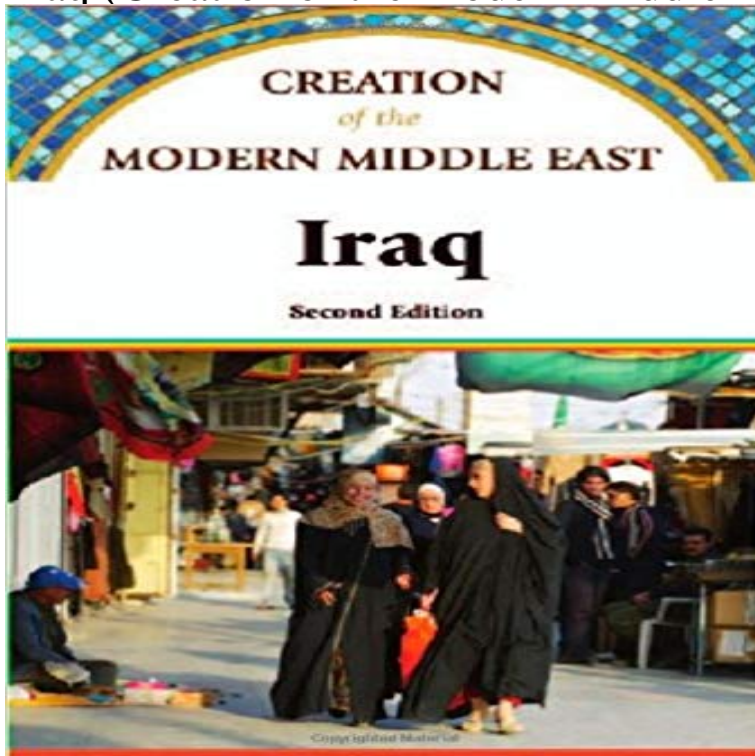


Iraq (Creation of the Modern Middle East)
