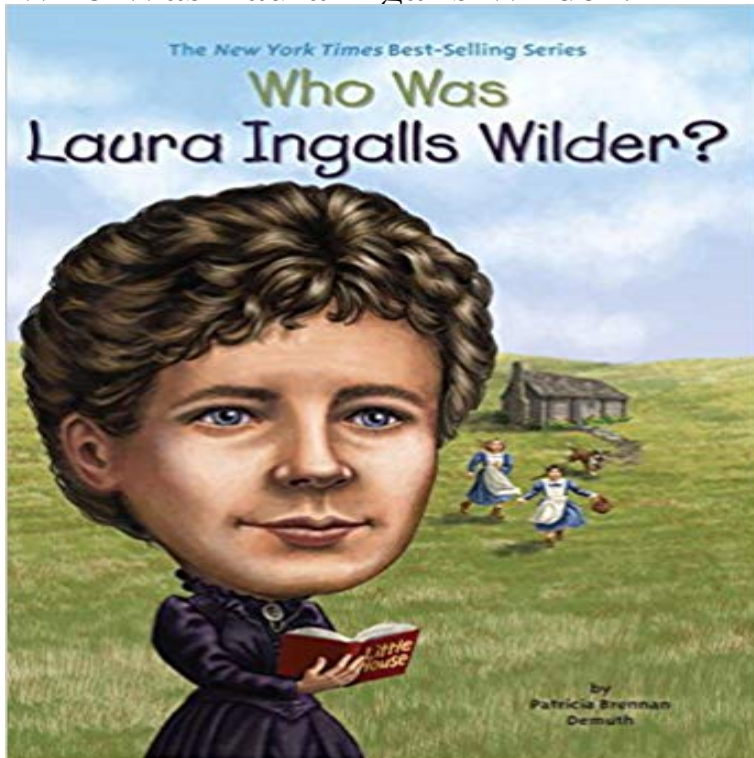


Who Was Laura Ingalls Wilder?
