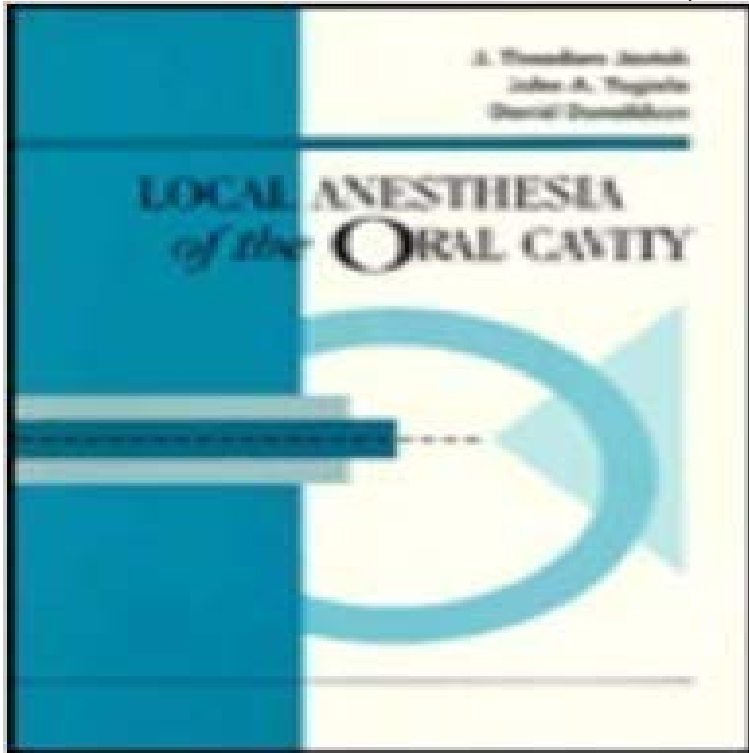


Local Anesthesia of the Oral Cavity
