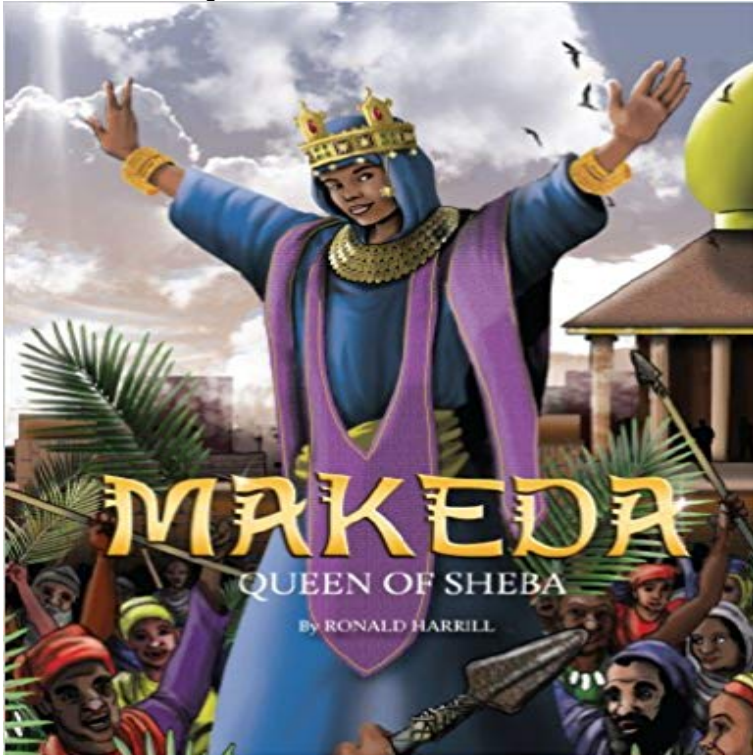


Makeda: Queen Of Sheba
