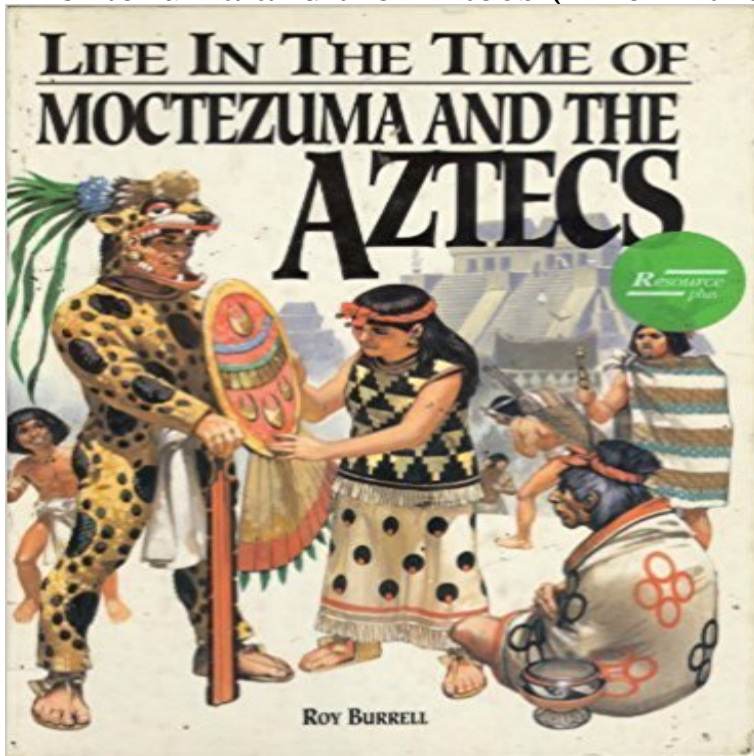


## Montezuma and the Aztecs (Life in the Time of)
