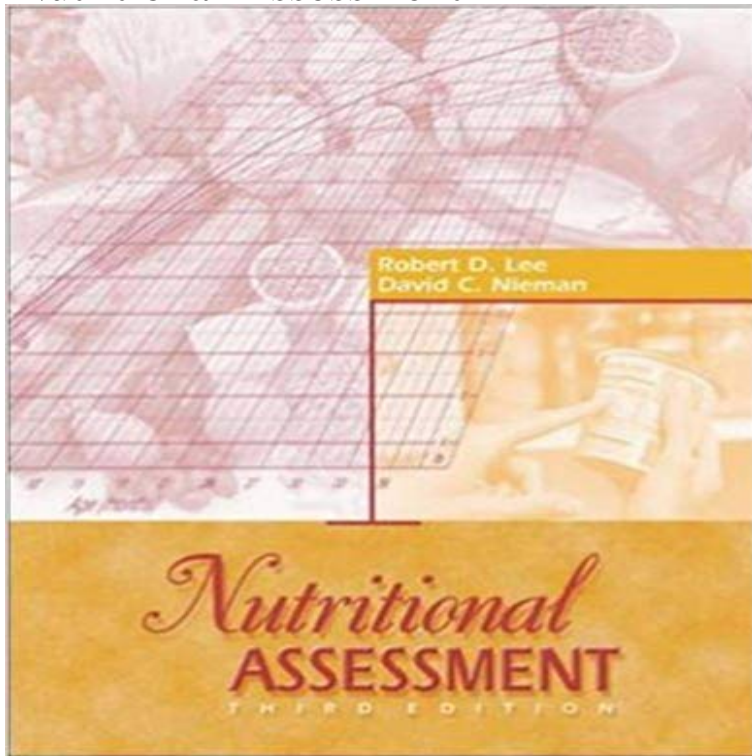


Nutritional Assessment
