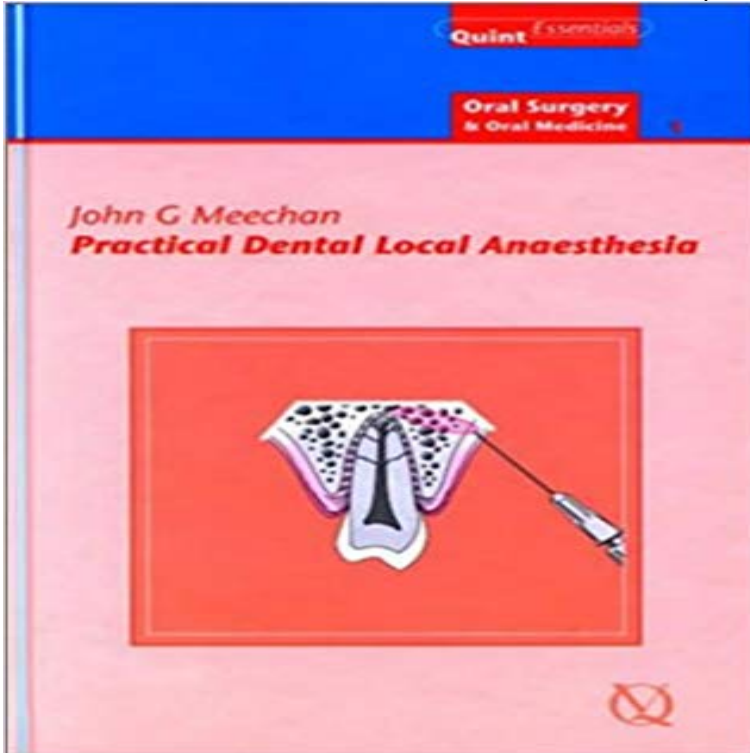


Practical Dental Local Anaesthesia (Oral Surgery Volume 1)
