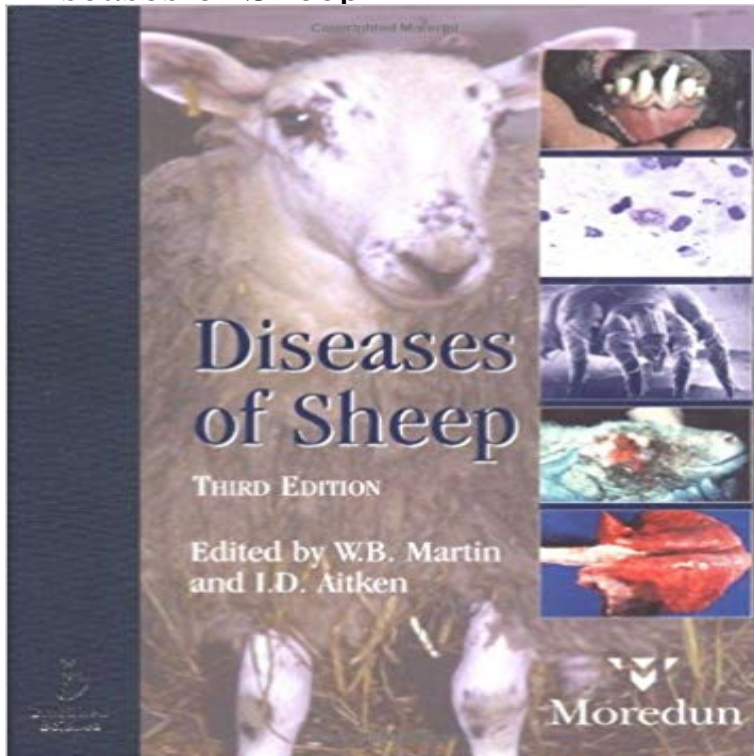


Diseases of Sheep
