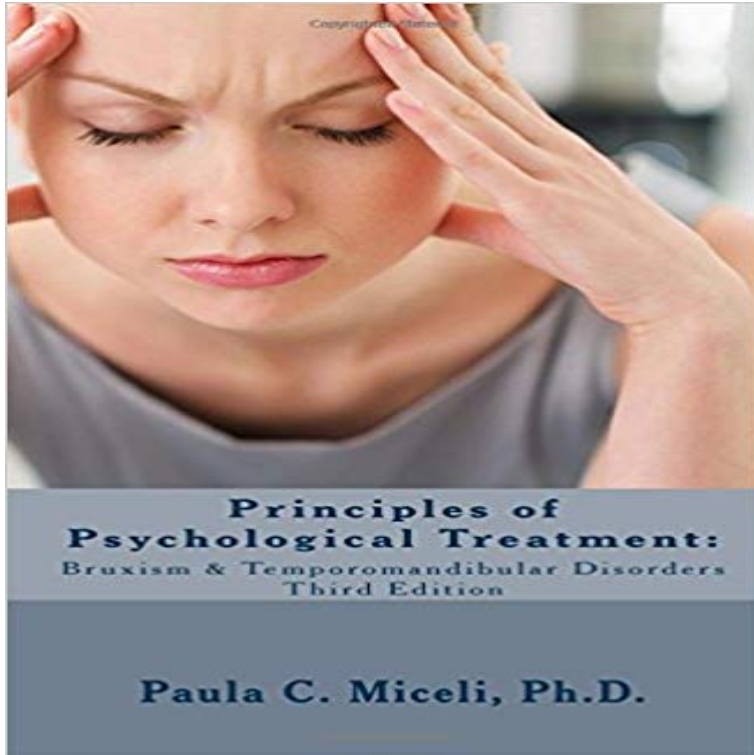


Principles of Psychological Treatment: Bruxism & Temporomandibular Disorders: A Research-Based Guide
