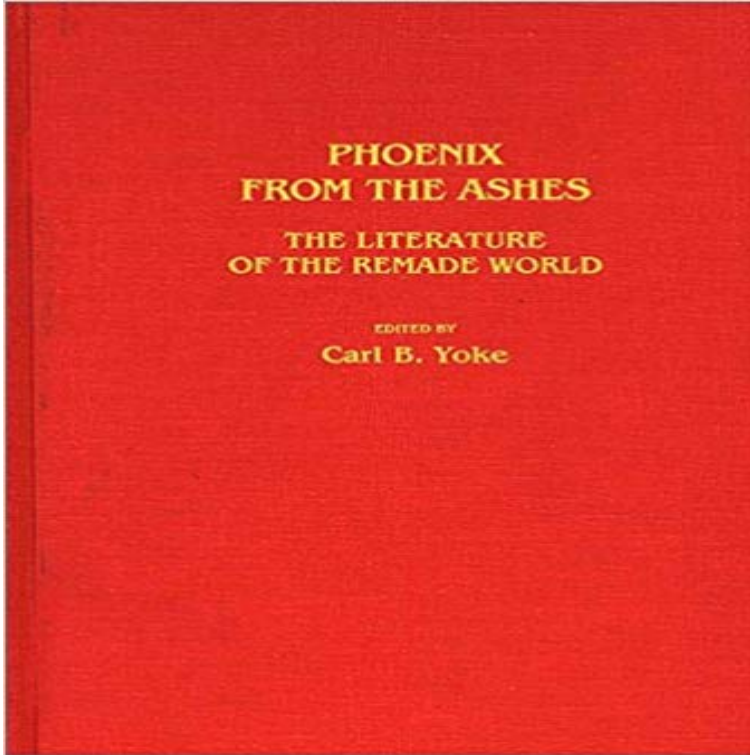


Phoenix From the Ashes: The Literature of the Remade World (Contributions to the Study of Science Fiction and Fantasy)
