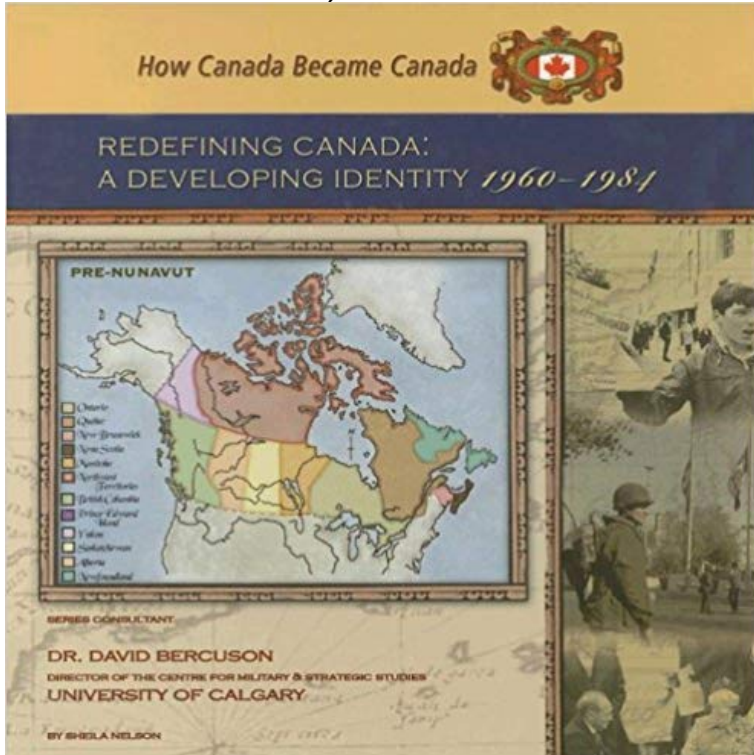


Redefining Canada: A Developing Identity, 1960-1984 (How Canada Became Canada)
