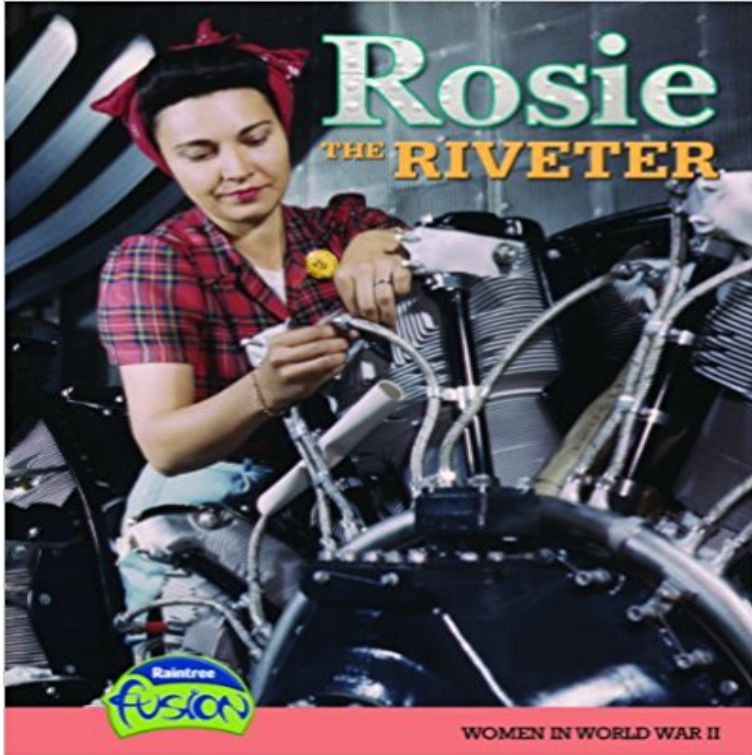


Rosie the Riveter: Women in World War II (American History Through Primary Sources)
