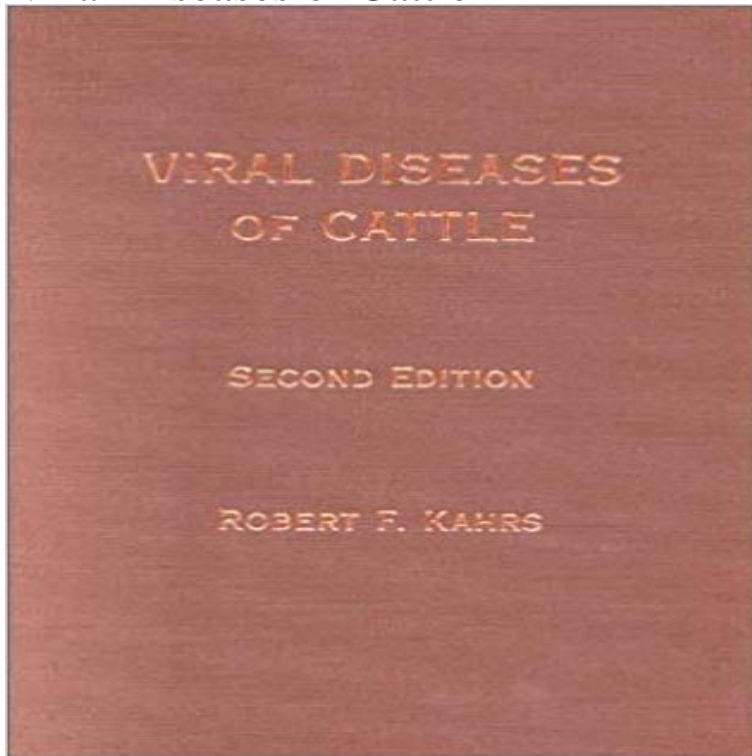


Viral Diseases of Cattle
