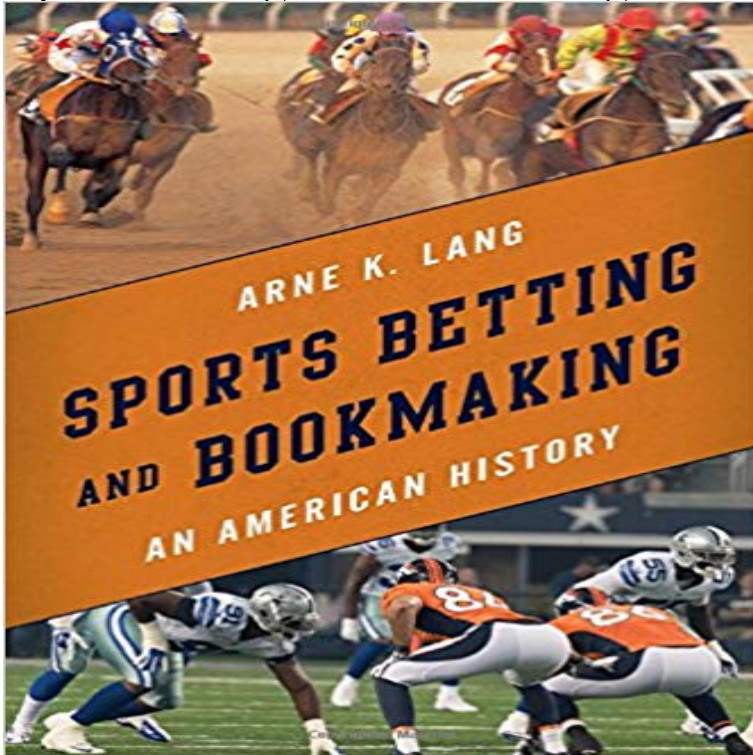


Sports Betting and Bookmaking: An American History
