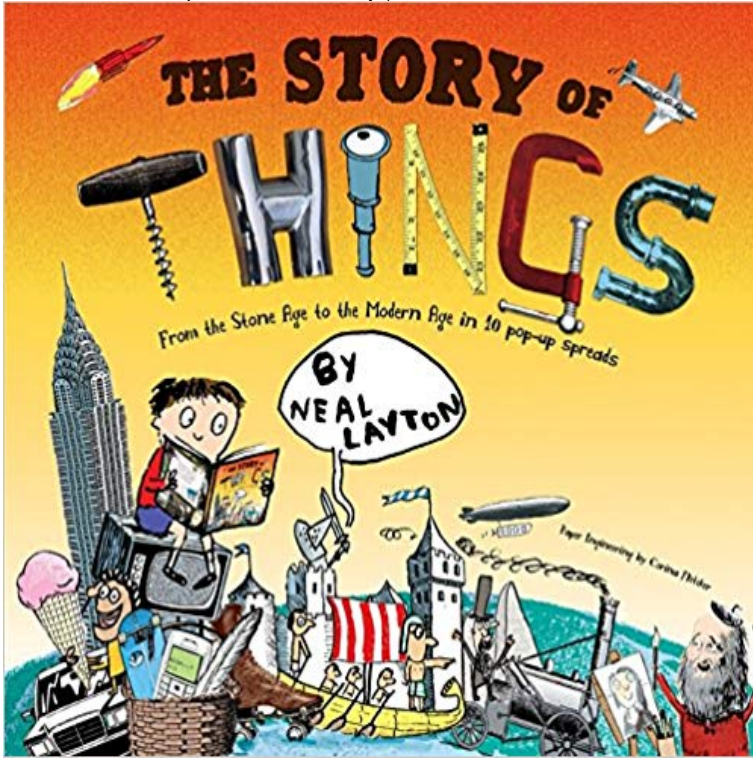


# The Story Of Things
