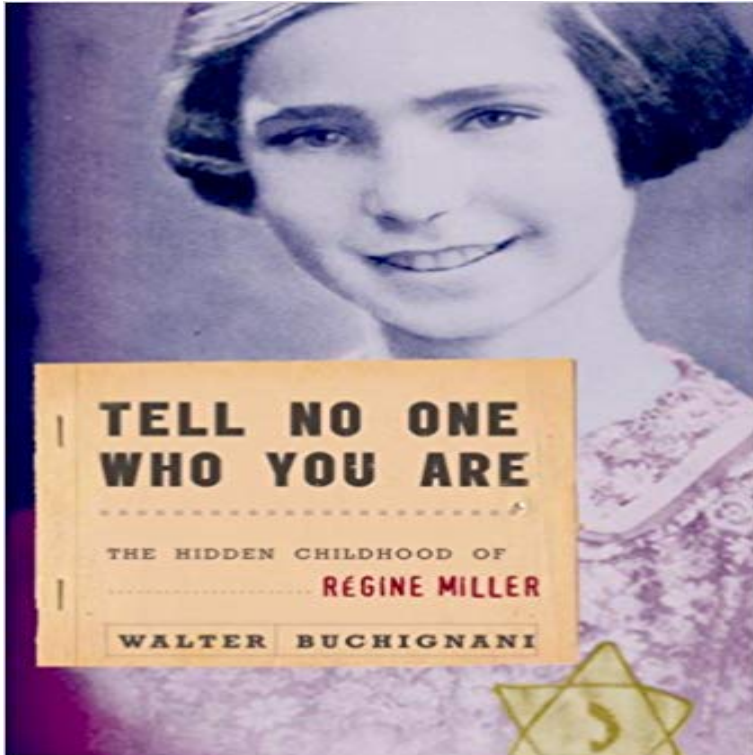


Tell No One Who You Are: The Hidden Childhood of Regine Miller
