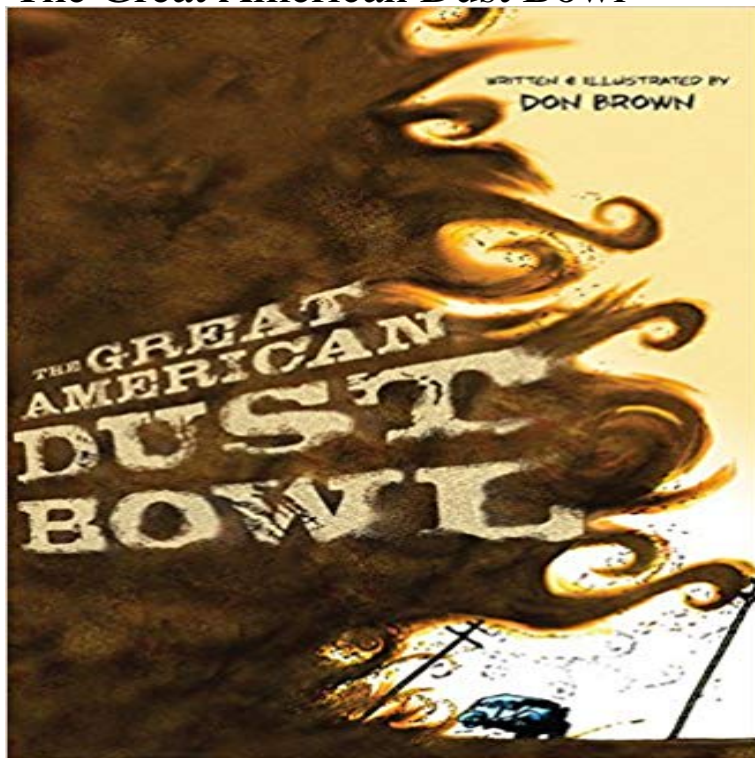


The Great American Dust Bowl
