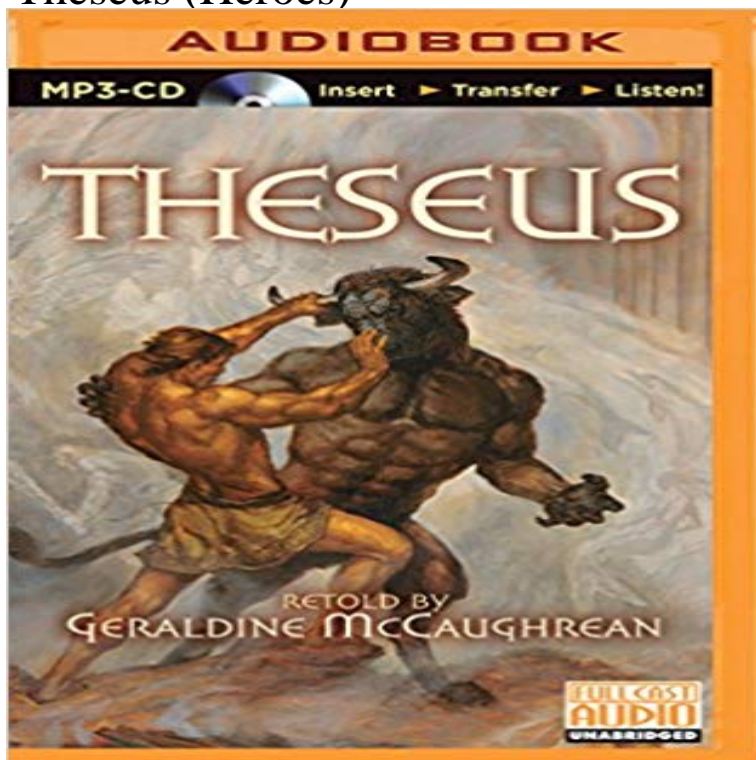


Theseus (Heroes)
