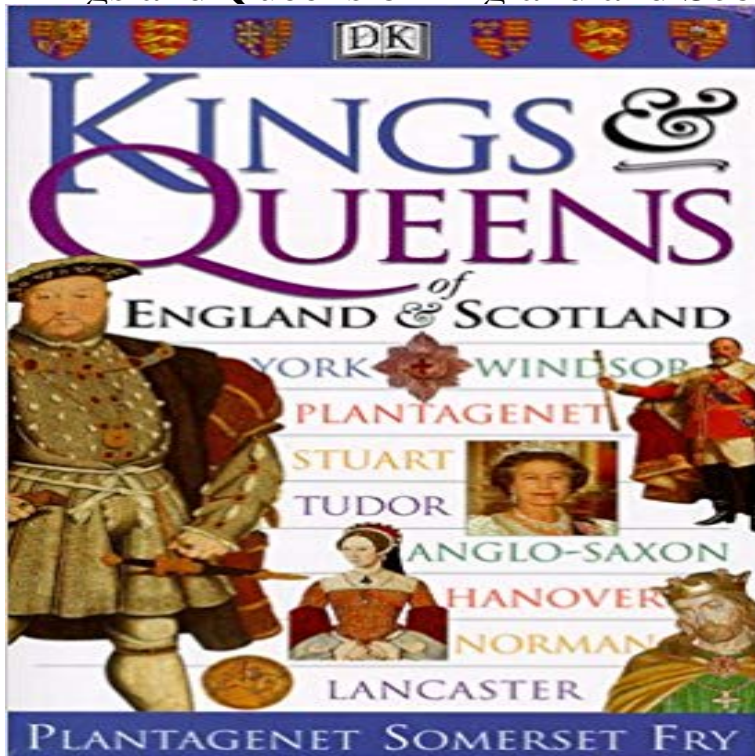


Kings and Queens of England and Scotland (Pockets)
