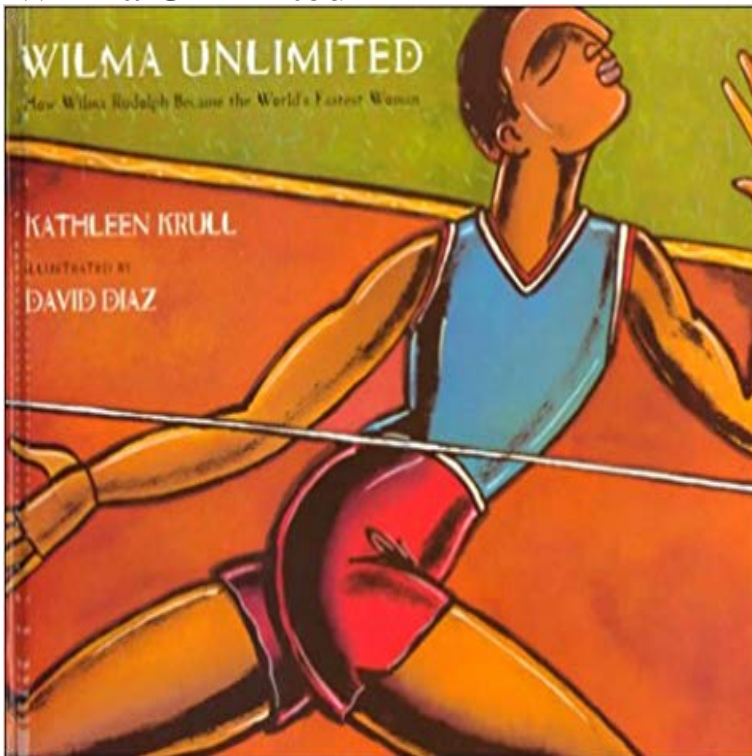


Wilma Unlimited
