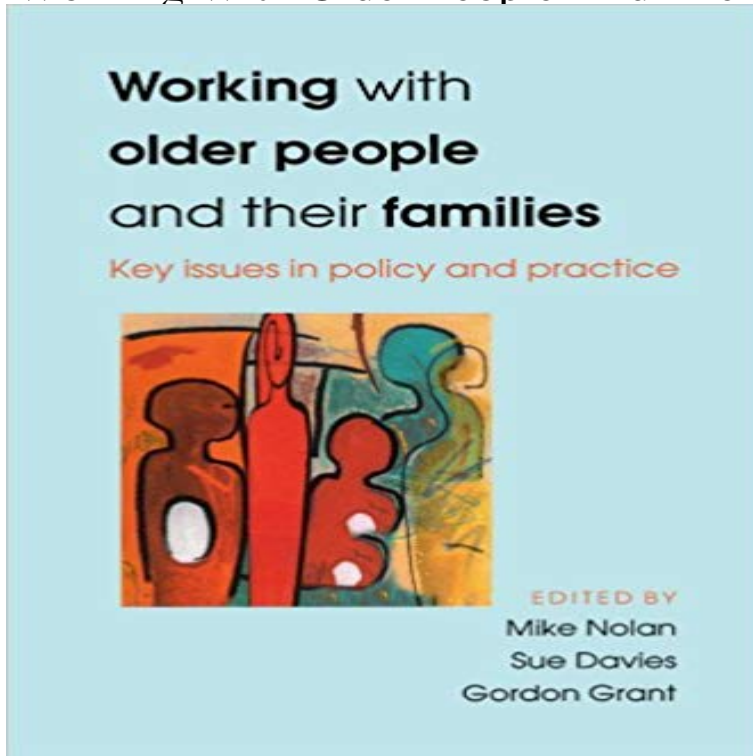


Working With Older People And Their Families
